7th CRY Cadence Corporate Cricket Challenge – “5Cs”

Rules and Regulations

Format

- Tournament dates - 24 June, 1,8 and 15 July (9 July will be the back up date incase of bad weather)
- Number of participating teams is 16. The teams would be divided into 2 groups; Group A and Group B consisting of 8 teams each. These groups will be formed by a draw of lots.
- The tournament will follow a knock out format. There would be 4 knock out matches per group and a total of 8 knock out matches. 4 knock out matches will be played per day i.e. 2 per group
- The winners of these 8 matches would play in the quarterfinal. There would be 4 quarter finals
- The winners of the quarterfinals would play in the semi finals. There would be 2 semi finals
- The winners of the semi final would enter the final.
- The 2 teams that enter the finals would have to play a total of 4 games in all. The teams reaching the semi-final will play for a total of 3 days.
- All the matches will be 20 overs per side.
- Each bowler is permitted to bowl a maximum 1/5 of total overs
- Each batsman will retire on reaching an individual score of 50 per match. They can return if all other members of their team have got out.

Others

- All the games will be played with a cricket ball.
- Teams should preferably wear whites. The organisers will provide T-shirts and caps. These should be worn for the matches.
- Each team to nominate one leg umpire and score keeper. They would umpire and keep scores for matches played by their own team. The main umpire would be a neutral umpire.
- In case of bad weather number of overs would be curtailed to 12. A match must have a minimum of 12 overs if bad weather does not allow the full 20 to be played. If less than 12 overs can be played then the game is rescheduled and restarted from scratch on 9 July. If it is still not possible to play rescheduled matches on the 9th July then the game will be decided by a toss
- In case there is a tie by number of runs scored then the number of wickets will be taken into consideration to decide the winner. If there is a tie on number of wickets as well then the game will be decided by a toss
- Only employees of the companies are allowed to participate. If you don't have a full team you can borrow members from the opposite team for fielding only, provided they agree
- CRY or Cadence will not be responsible for any injury to players in course of the match/tournament.
- The registration form will include a team list, which would have a maximum of 15 players from every organization. The names of the teams to be submitted to Nina on the day of the match
- Every team has to carry its own playing kit that includes personal kit, bats and helmet. Cricket balls and stumps will be provided.
- The umpires shall decide awards like the 'Man of the Match' along with the organiser. This decision shall be considered final and binding.
- If any team arrives more than half an hour late, the match would be treated as forfeited and the other team shall get a walkover.
- Following is the timing of the matches which should be strictly followed
 - Morning Session – 9 am to 12.30 pm
 - Afternoon Session – 1 pm to 4.30 pm
