8th CRY Cadence Corporate Cricket Challenge – “5Cs”

Rules and Regulations

Format

- Tournament dates – 23,30 June, 7,14 July (21 July will be the back up date incase of bad weather)
- Number of participating teams is 16. The teams would be divided into 4 groups of 4 teams each.
- The tournament will follow a league format and each team will play 3 matches at this stage
- One winning team from each group would play in the semifinal.
 - If there is a tie at the league stage then the winning team will be decided by NRR
 - If the NRR is also the same then winners will be decided based on the match result in the league match
- Winners of group A will play winners of group B and C will play D in the semi-finals
- The winners of the semi final would enter the final and loosing teams would play for the 3rd and 4th position.
- The winning teams would play a maximum of 5 matches
- The winning team will score 2 points in the league stage, incase of a tie the teams will get 1 point each
- The league matches will be 15 overs per side while the semi-final and final will be 20 overs.
- Each bowler is permitted to bowl a maximum 1/5 of total overs
- Each batsman will retire on reaching an individual score of 50 per match. They can return if all other members of their team have got out.

Others

- All the games will be played with a cricket ball.
- Teams should preferably wear whites. The organisers will provide T-shirts that should be worn for the matches.
- Each team to nominate one umpire and score keeper. They would umpire and keep scores for matches played by their own team.
- Organisers would provide neutral umpires for the semi-finals and final
- In case there is a tie by number of runs scored at the semi-final and final then
 - The number of wickets will be taken into consideration to decide the winner.
 - If there is a tie on number of wickets, then points scored in at the league stage would be considered
 - If above two are the same then, then total runs scored in the league would be considered
 - If all above is the same then the one bowler from each side gets to bowl at a single stump for one over. The side getting the maximum hits is the winner, if the scores for this are also same then there we follow sudden death
- Out of a team of 15 each company can nominate up to 5 members who could be ex-employees or current business partners. This has to be confirmed by the HR department on the company letter head or via e-mail

- In case of bad weather number of overs would be curtailed to 10 at the league stage and 15 at the semi-final and final stage
 - If the first side is not able to complete 10 overs at the league stage/12 in semi-final and final, then play is abandoned and the match will be rescheduled by the organizers
 - If the first side has played more than 10 overs in league/12 in semi-final and final than the match will continue from where it had been left on a day decided by the organizers
- CRY or Cadence will not be responsible for any injury to players in course of the match/tournament.
- The registration form will include a team list, which would have a maximum of 15 players from every organization. The names of the teams to be submitted to Nina on the day of the match
- Every team has to carry its own playing kit that includes personal kit, bats and helmet. Cricket balls and stumps will be provided.
- For boundary decisions the umpire may have to rely on the boundary fielder for a decision.
- Umpires decision will be binding and any untoward incidents would be penalized by barring player from the match
- The umpires and captains shall decide awards like the 'Man of the Match' along with the organiser. This decision shall be considered final and binding.
- If any team arrives more than half an hour late, the match would be treated as forfeited and the other team shall get a walkover.
- Following is the timing for the league matches which should be strictly followed
 - Morning Session – 10 am to 12.15 pm
 - Afternoon Session – 12.30 pm to 2.45 pm
 - Evening Session - 3 pm to 5.15 pm
